Program Description:

Healthy Kids Afterschool Alliance is an afterschool partnership alliance offered through the YMCA of Chilton County. This partnership is between the YMCA of Chilton County, Liberty Hill Baptist Church, and Lomax Assembly of God. This program will allow expanded services for students and provide convenient transportation services for parents. The safety of your children will always be the most important factor considered as procedures are established. Please choose the afterschool site that meets your desired dismissal time and schedule of activities.

Site 1: YMCA of Chilton County

Site 2: Liberty Hill Baptist Church

Site 3: Lomax Assembly of God

Tuition:

Weekly payments are due no later than Wednesday of each week and should be paid to the site supervisor at students site location or the YMCA of Chilton County. Checks should be made payable to YMCA of Chilton County. All checks must include phone number, physical address, and students name. Weekly tuition is not prorated by days of operation. The first week's tuition must be paid before the child can attend the program. Tuition is the same regardless of absences or number of days attended.

Scholarships:

Scholarship applications are available if you need financial assistance.

Multiple Children:

Cost for second child at another location is the same as the first child. Families with more than two children in the program will be charged \$10 per week per additional child.

Transportation Guidelines:

Students will be transported on a Chilton County School Bus. The transportation services provided daily by HKAA are:

- Daily transport from home school to appropriate site location.
- There will be no transportation between sites.

Check Out:

A checkout card must be on file listing 8 adults who may check out your child. Picture ID is required when a child is checked out. Parents must sign students out if leaving the afterschool program early. ***Students are in various locations, so please allow 15 minutes for us to locate your child and bring them to the check-out area.***

Severe Weather:

In the event of severe weather, afterschool students will be taken to a safe zone in the building. If school dismisses for severe weather, the afterschool program will not operate. Please have a severe weather plan.

Key Details

- Healthy Kids Afterschool Alliance serves the following schools: CES, CIS, CMS, JES, JIS, THS, IHS, MHS, JMS, and CCA
- Program Cost & Hours: \$30 per week (September – May) 3:00pm – 6:30pm (Monday-Friday)
- All participants must select a program site. Once students are checked in to the site, there will be no further transportation provided.

Communication:

Please be certain the HKAA has a correct and valid email address to communicate with you. Please check this email daily for important dates and information.

Dinner:

We will serve dinner daily at all 3 sites between 4pm and 5pm. In an effort to be efficient, we will ask parents to notify the site supervisor each day if your child will be eating the following day.
