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## Summer Camp 2023: Information Sheet (Signature required on last page)

Initial each line please.

- \_\_\_\_\_ First day of camp starts Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup> and will end Friday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. There will be 9 weeks of camp.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Camp hours are 6:30 am - 6:00 pm.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Counselors and assistant counselors will be dressed in orange so that they are easy to identify.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Campers need to check in by 8:45 am. If you check in after 8:45 am, you will be responsible for transporting your child to their group's location. Campers may not check in to camp without a doctor's excuse after 8:45 am.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Campers will be off campus 8:45 am - 2:45 pm most days. 3<sup>rd</sup> graders and older will be transported by bus to Lomax Assembly of God to complete activities at 9am each day and return after lunch at 11:45am. Parents of children 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and older will need to sign a permission slip to travel each week.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Our second location will be Lomax Assembly of God. Campers should not check in or out at Lomax Assembly of God.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breakfast is served 7:30 am - 8:15 am. Campers may not check in to camp without a doctor's excuse after 8:45 am.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breakfast, lunch, and snack will be served every day. All food served meets USDA nutritional guidelines. We focus on teaching healthy lifestyle choices. Please encourage your child to eat the healthy options. Only send a lunch if your child has food allergies. Milk is required by USDA for each meal. If your child cannot have milk, please bring a note signed by your physician.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Do not send a fast-food meal. If you pick up fast food for breakfast, make sure they eat before entering the Y to check in.
- \_\_\_\_\_ We no longer have a snack vending machine.
- \_\_\_\_\_ You must walk your child in each morning and sign him/her in and walk in each afternoon for pick up.
- \_\_\_\_\_ You must sign a medical release each week for bug spray and sunblock and it will be applied at camp.
- \_\_\_\_\_ You must sign a field trip form each week for your child to walk to the pool.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Payment is due for the week every Monday. After Wednesday, a late fee of \$10 will be added. Children will not be admitted if payment is not received.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If you use the Family Guidance system, cards must be swiped daily.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Weeks of absenteeism will not be charged if written notice is given to the front desk prior to the absences.



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\_\_\_\_\_ Everyday your child needs to bring:

- a. Water bottle- name on outside
- b. Beach towel - name on tag or towel
- c. Drawstring bag or backpack- name listed on outside.
- d. Dry clothes - name listed in tag of each item.
- e. Make sure your child wears tennis shoes. No sandals or flip flops allowed. No CROCS allowed.

\_\_\_\_\_ Your child should bring the following the first day of camp:

- a. Sunblock with his/her name on it
- b. Bug Spray with his/her name on it

\_\_\_\_\_ Campers who are K - 2<sup>nd</sup> grade should come every day dressed in a swimsuit with cover up or shirt. They will swim 9:00 am - 11:15 am daily.

\_\_\_\_\_ Please apply sunscreen each morning before your child comes to camp. Make sure they have a bag (drawstring backpack is best) with dry clothes for after swimming and a towel. Make sure all items have name listed on them.

\_\_\_\_\_ Campers' 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and up will swim each day 12:00 pm - 2:15 pm. Please send an appropriate swimsuit, towel, and sunscreen.

\_\_\_\_\_ Check outs begin at 2:45 pm. Campers are busy at multiple locations until 2:45 pm. If an emergency arises, please call ahead or expect a 20-30-minute wait time upon arrival.

\_\_\_\_\_ If you register your child for swim lessons, gymnastics, TKD, soccer or baton camp, please notify the front desk at drop off each morning. He/she will not follow the typical schedule for that day. A list of these additional programs will be posted at a later date.

\_\_\_\_\_ Do **NOT** allow your child to bring a cell phone, a watch that operates like a phone, electronics, games, toys, or cards to summer camp. Do not let them bring any items that may be disruptive to camp. We are not responsible for stolen items. Campers with cell phones will be suspended.

\_\_\_\_\_ Any toys, cards, or cell phones will be taken up and held at the front desk will check out.

\_\_\_\_\_ Tuition will be charged at a rate of \$125.00 a week for YMCA members, \$150.00 a week for non-members, & a daily rate of \$40.00. Families with more than 2 children will receive half price for a third & more children.
